Yes, it is I, that genealogical pest, who keeps bugging you for more data and information.

Over the past couple of years I've learned much about the Burris Ross family of the mid-1850's in Crawford County, IN. In fact, I now know about Burris' four children and two different wives. And also, the fact that he and his immediate family were counted twice in the 1850 census.

However, I'm still not able to pin down his specific time/place of birth/death, nor information about his parents and siblings. Please refer to the attached summary. My "gut feel" is that he was born in Kentucky, but I have no true substantiation of this fact.

Please give me the wisdom of your advice as to what you think my next steps should be. Would there be any value in my considering hiring a researcher to further my quest? I am retired with sparse funds, and I would hate to spend some money, just to have someone else retrace the paths which I've already gone down. What do you think?

BURRIS ROSS

(great-grandfather to Frances Helen Ross Jones, Marengo, IN) (great-grandfather to Michael Thompson Ross, Ashland, OR)

Where was he born? State-of-Indiana-Certified death certificate for his daughter, Lucinda Evaline (Jones), indicates Burrus (sic) was born in "Missouri". (informant was J. B. Jones, English, IN, April 25, 1915) State-of-Indiana-Certified death certificate for his son, Thomas Jefferson, indicates that Burrus (sic) was born in "Ireland". (informant was John L. Ross, Marengo, IN, January 23, 1929) 1910 Indiana census, Liberty Township, Crawford County, for Thomas Ross family, indicates that the father was born in "Tennessee". 1900 Indiana census, Southeast Township, Orange County, for Thomas J. Ross family, indicates that the father was born in "Tennessee". 1850 Indiana census, District Forty Five, Harrison County, August 14, 1850, indicates that Burries (sic) was a farmer born in "Ohio". 1850 Indiana census, Jennings Township, Crawford County, October 11, 1850, indicates that Buras (sic) was a boatsman born in "Kentucky".

When was he born? 1850 Indiana census, District Forty Five, Harrison County, August 14, 1850, indicates he was 34 years old. 1850 Indiana census, Jennings Township, Crawford County, October 11, 1850, indicates he was 35 years old. On this basis we may extrapolate that he was born in 1815, between August 14, and October 11.

Where did he die? Family lore has it that he died in either Crawford or Orange County, IN.

When did he die? His fourth child, Ambrose S. Ross, was born in 1856, and his second wife, the child's mother, Margaret Dooly, remarried, May 3, 1860. Therefore, it is assumed Burris Ross died sometime between 1856 - 1860.

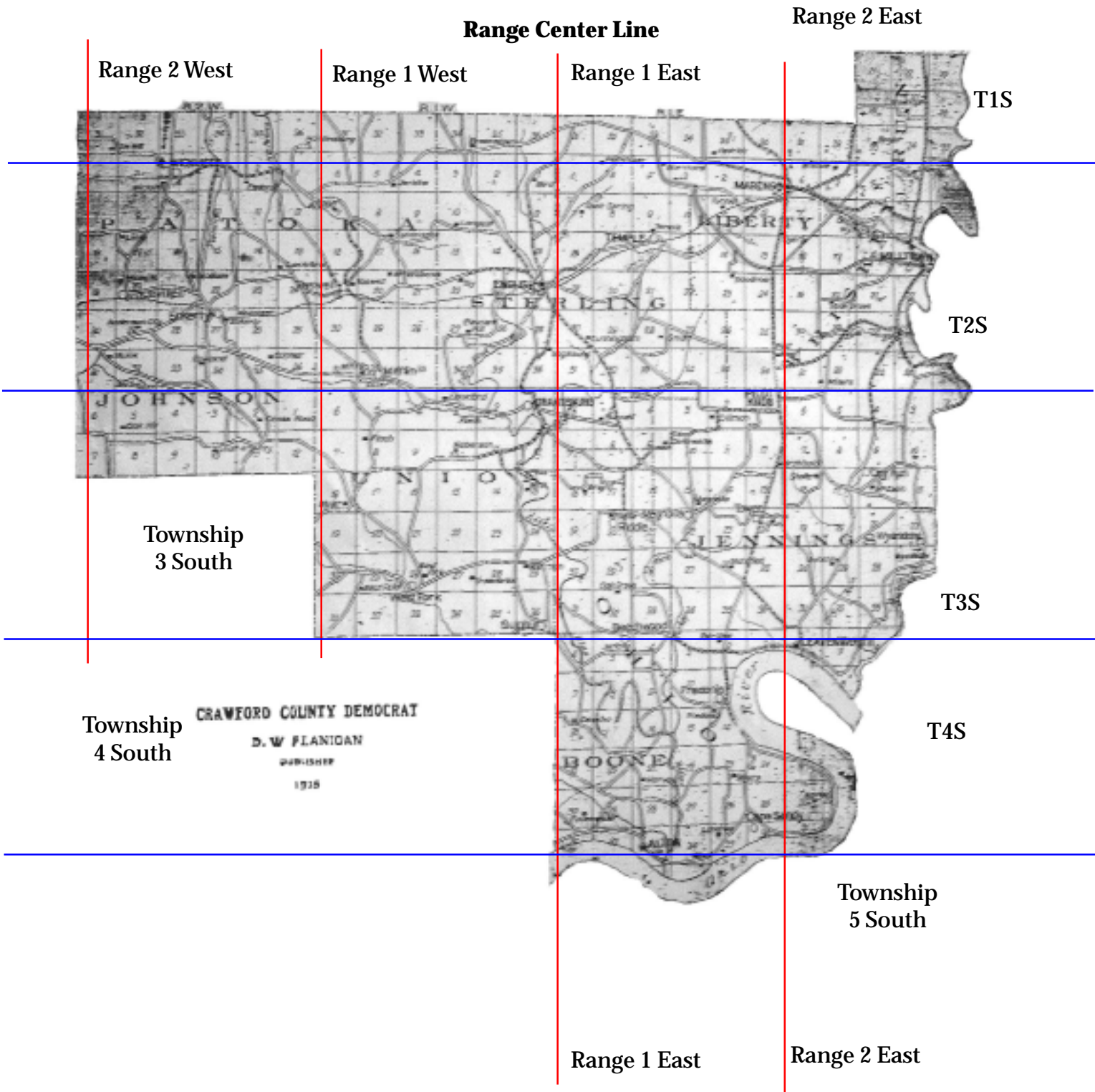

The Bounty Tax Records

These records were copied from the Commissioner's Records by Richard Eastridge. He gave them to me to put on the computer and maybe to eventually put something together in book form on the Civil War and Crawford County. The record included some 37 pages that were of the tax records for the years 1865, 1866, and 1867 payable in 1866, 1867 and 1868. The records also included 7 pages listing funds given to veteran families for what was called "Soldiers Family Relief Fund." The preceding list of names is from the Bounty Tax records. Some veterans were named in all three years, some only in one year, and some not at all. Veterans did not have funds subtracted from their bounty money unless their property tax bill became delinquent, then the amount was subtracted from their payment. After copying the names only into a file, I then deleted those that appeared more than once. However some may appear more than once with a different spelling of the name.
